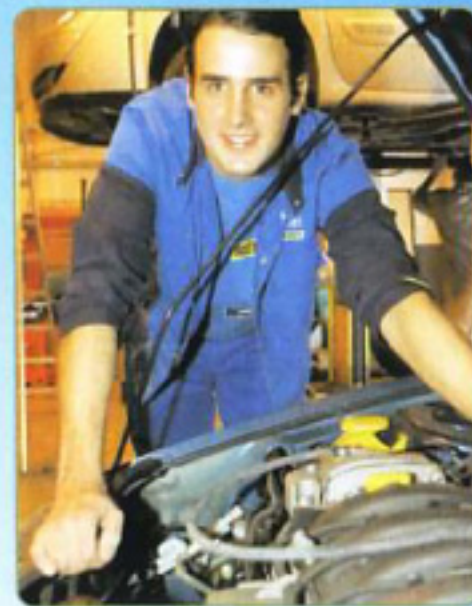
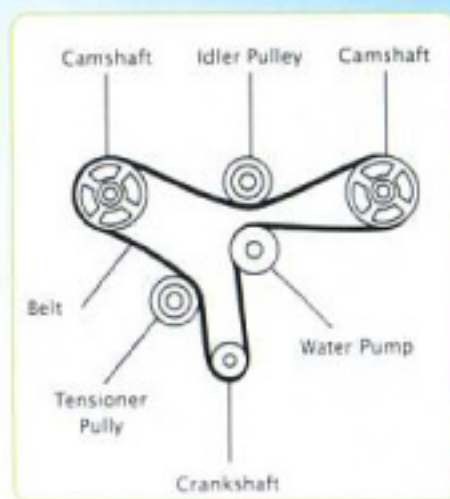

According to our records, your vehicle has now reached a point at which it is advisable to check the timing belt. Timing belts fail without warning and the only protection is to change the belt at the recommended intervals - every 5 years or 72,000 to 99,000 miles (depending on model of vehicle) - to avoid and costly harm to your engine. If your timing belt does break, your engine can suffer serious damage and repairs can be expensive. It could result in your engine having to be replaced.



What does the timing belt do?

A timing belt, often also called a cam belt, is a flat rubber belt with internal teeth. Basically the belt transfers drive from the crankshaft in the lower part of the engine, to the camshaft at the top of the engine. The accurate position of the belt on its driving sprockets allows the engine valves to open and close at the exact moment to ensure optimum engine performance.
